



October Convention Pandemic Info

CoG follows the Senior Center's rules, which follow the city, county, and state rules.

1. Masks must be worn in the facility except when eating and drinking. You are welcome to buy a 3M 8210Plus N95 grade mask at registration for \$5.
2. Occupancy limits for rooms have been posted at room entrances. You may not stay in a room if the room is beyond the posted capacity.
3. Proof of vaccination is not required for attendees, with the exception of the Blossom Room. To meet the elevated risk concerns of some attendees, you must have a visible copy of your vaccination card, on your person, at all times. NO EXCEPTIONS! Masks must also be worn there at ALL times, so you will have to leave the room to eat or drink. Get any needed card holders from registration.
4. Some of the facility's rooms have windows and doors which can be opened for fresh air. You should probably bring a sweater or light coat if you want to sit near them, especially in the evening.
5. Five picnic tables are located outside the Sun Room. If wind and rain aren't a problem, feel free to use them. Because they are not within the facility, groups using the tables can set their own mask and vaccination policies.
6. Those who wish to clean tables before play should bring their own materials for cleaning, so they may be sure table surfaces are safe.
